

## Roll-up Pouch

One size



### Fabric usage

40 cm fabric  
200 cm bias tape

### Fabric advice

Stepped



## Instructions

### Printer settings

Print this document at full size. For orientation, select automatic.

### Materials

- 40 cm stepped fabric
- 200 cm bias tape
- 1 button
- 15 cm thin elastic

### Pattern pieces

1. Main panel 1x
2. Pocket panel 1x

### Instructions

1. Print the pattern at full size. You can check whether the pattern is the correct size by measuring the square.
2. Cut out both pattern pieces. No seam allowance needs to be added.
3. Finish the straight upper edge of the pocket panel with bias tape.
4. Place the pocket panel right side up on the inside of the main panel, aligning the bottom edges. Pin in place.
5. Using a disappearing marker or tailor's chalk, mark stitching lines every 6 cm on the pocket panel. Stitch along the lines to form the pockets and secure both layers together.
6. Finish the outer edge with an overlock stitch or zigzag stitch for extra durability.
7. Attach the elastic to the right-hand side on the outside of the main panel, placing the loop facing inward.
8. Finish the outer edge with bias tape.
9. Roll up the mat to determine the placement of the button. Sew the button on.
