

















# Instructions

## Required materials

- 1 DIY panel, article 03280 from POPPY FABRICS
- Matching fabric for the backside, in total 85x140 cm, see *cut to size* below for the elements that needs to be cut
- Teddy fabric in total 20x80 cm, see *cut to size* below for the elements that needs to be cut
- Cotton filling
- Interfacing
- Sewing machine and stitching thread
- Needle and thread
- Rope or ribbon
- Small piece of crisp paper
- 4 wooden rings
- Matching ribbon for the pig tail, page 2 of the book
- Optional: black felt in total 10x10 cm for the mane of the donkey hanger
- Optional: shiny fabric 3x4 cm for page 7 of the book

## Pattern pieces

- 1. Playmat sheep front 1x
- 2. Babygym hangers 4x
- 3. Activity book 1x

#### Cut to size

- Shiny Fabric 3x4 cm for page 7 of the book we recommend article 06508.025
- Black felt 10x10 cm for the donkey's manes on the babygym hanger
- Small ribbon for the pigtail 5 cm

#### Poplin Fabric, we recommend article 06006.005:

- Backside sheep body > 80x100 cm
- Backside sheep face > 20x25 cm
- Backside sheep ears 2x > 12x13 cm
- Backside sheep legs 4x > 6x13,5 cm
- Sheep babygym hanger 2x > 7x12 cm
- Sheep forelock face playmat 2x > 16x25 cm
- Forelock sheep P6 of the book > 5x7 cm

#### Teddy Fabric, we recommend article 07030.001:

- Sheep babygym hanger  $2x > 7 \times 12$  cm
- Sheep forelock face playmat  $2x > 16 \times 25$  cm
- Forelock sheep P6 of the book > 5 x 7 cm

#### Instructions

1. First, cut out all of the parts.

### Sheep's head pillow:

- 2. Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the ears.
- **3.** Place the right sides of the ears on a matching fabric from the backside.
- **4.** Place the right sides of the two ears together, stitch them together leaving an opening for turning, turn around and keep apart.
- **5.** Cut 2 pieces of the teddy for the forelock of the sheep.
- **6.** Cut 2 pieces of the same shape of the forelock from the poplin fabric.
- 7. Place the front side of the sheep's face on the backside of a matching fabric for the backside, pin in place and cut the same shape as the face.
- **8.** Place the good side of the teddy forelock to the good side of the poplin, pin in place, sew together, leaving an opening to turn. Do for both front and back.
- 9. Turn around and close the opening.
- **10.** Place the teddy front forelock on the right side of the sheep's face and stitch together on top of the forelock. Do the same for the backside.
- **11.** Place the good sides of the face on each other, place the ears between , pin together and sew around, leaving an opening to turn and to fill.
- **12.** Turn around, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.

# Legs:

- **13.** Place the frontside of the legs on matching fabric for the backside, with the right sides together.
- 14. Pin in place and cut the same shape as the legs.
- **15.** Stitch front and back together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
- 16. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and keep apart.

# Body:

- **17.** Place the right side of the front of the sheep on the right side of matching backside fabric, pin in place and cut the same shape as the body.
- 18. Place the 4 legs on the preferred place of the body.
- **19.** Stitch front and back of the body together with the 4 legs of the sheep on the preferred place of the body. Leave an opening for the cotton filling.
- **20.** Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- 21. Topstitch along the thin wavy lines printed on the body.
- **22.** Stitch the head by hand to the body of the sheep.

# Babygym Hangers:

Cow, Donkey and Pig:

23. Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the ear pieces.

- **24.** Place the right sides of the ears together, stitch them together leaving an opening for turning.
- **25.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **26.** Place the faces with the right sides together and pin the ears between (for the donkey hanger, place also the manes in between) leaving an opening on the top side for the cotton filling and ribbon.
- **27.** Sew and then turn the fabrics, fill with cotton filling, add a ribbon in the opening for the hangers to attach to the babygym and close the opening.

## Sheep:

- 28. Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the ear pieces.
- **29.** Place the right sides of the ears together, stitch them together leaving an opening for turning.
- **30.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **31.** Cut 2 pieces of the teddy for the forelock of the sheep.
- **32.** Cut 2 pieces of the same shape from the forelock from the poplin fabric.
- **33.** Place the good side from the teddy forelock to the good side poplin, pin in place, sew together, leaving an opening to turn. Do for both Teddy pieces.
- **34.** Turn around and close the opening.
- **35.** Place the teddy front forelock on the right side of the sheep's face and stitch on top of the forelock together. Do the same for the backside.
- **36.** Place the faces with the right sides together and pin the ears between leaving an opening on the top side for the cotton filling and ribbon.
- **37.** Sew and then turn the fabrics, fill with cotton filling, add a ribbon in the opening for the hangers to attach to the babygym and close the opening.

Optional 1: add a rattlebox inside the babygym hangers. Optional 2: attach the ears of the donkey to the wooden rings with thread so the ears will stay up. You can modify all the different ears for each animal.

#### Activity book

**38.** Iron interfacing on the following parts: Pages 3, 4, 5, 6 and on the brown strip of P1 and P8.

## Page 1

**39.** Requires no editing.

#### Page 2

**40.** Add a curly tail to the pig made from a ribbon or out of the selvedge.

# Page 3

- **41.** Add crisp paper on the inside of one of the basket pieces.
- **42.** Place the right sides of the baskets together, stitch them

- together leaving an opening for turning.
- **43.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **44.** Attach the basket on the harvest on page 3 of the activity book.

## Page 4

- **45.** Add crisp paper on the inside of one of the ear pieces.
- **46.** Place the right sides of the ears together, stitch them together leaving an opening for turning.
- **47.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **48.** Attach the ears on the cow on page 4 of the activity book.

# Page 5

- **49.** Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the doors.
- **50.** Place the right sides of the doors together, stitch them together leaving an opening for turning.
- **51.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **52.** Attach the door to the barn on page 5 of the activity book.

# Page 6

- **53.** Cut 1 piece of the teddy for the forelock of the sheep.
- **54.** Cut 1 piece of the same shape from the forelock from the poplin fabric.
- **55.** Place the good side from the teddy forelock to the good side poplin, pin in place, sew together, leaving an opening to turn.
- **56.** Turn around and close the opening.
- **57.** Place the teddy front forelock on the right side of the sheep's face and stitch on top of the forelock together.

#### Page 7

**58.** Optional: add a shiny fabric to the window of the tractor, we recommend: art 06508.025.

#### Page 8

- **59.** Requires no editing.
- **60.** Place P2 and P7 with the right side on the right side of P1 and P8. Sew all around, and leave an opening to turn.
- **61.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **62.**Repeat this step for the other pages.
- **63.** Put the pages on top of each other in the correct order.
- **64.** Topstitch on both long sides of the brown strip.
